He served as a member of the S&P U.S. Index Committee from 2002 to 2010, and holds a U.S. patent related to style benchmarks. Additionally, Srikant has authored several research papers on index issues such as the widely followed SPIVA™ (S&P Index Versus Active) and Persistence Scorecards.

Srikant joined Standard & Poor's in 2000 as manager of global index analysis. He is a Fellow of the Global Association of Risk Professionals and a CFA charter holder.
